The agenda was ordered to allow additions during the business session.

- I. Gary Matthews report. Gary reported on :the ASAA website revision, reclassification, and sportsmanship. Two sportsmanship packets**

were given to Region II to share. One will be put on the website at www.ptialaska.net/~track1 for member schools. [Note the ability to send your master eligibility list and roster for state to ASAA via their website.]

II Dean Overbey gave the Region II Board representative report. Dean discussed the Board's plan for action on reclassification. There were several questions regarding

the effects on Region II. (Note: this has not been adopted yet schools have been moved from Region II to Region I and basketball Districts have been reorganized. Be sure to check your school's affiliation to see that you are anticipating appropriate competition in volleyball and basketball.)

The magic number for Region II to receive a full venue for AAA schools remains at four. The wrestling season will remain the same. The Greatland Hockey conference will remain intact until there are nine teams. Then the conference will have a playoff and the top the team(s) will go to the State Hockey Tournament.

- II. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved following a motion by Dean and second by Matt Clark.**
- III. Treasurer's report was discussed and it was decided to add a budget projection and to look at the track and cross country running tournament expense to see if the entry fee needs revised. This was added to New Business. Matt Clark moved and Alan Clemens 2nd to accept. Passed.**

- IV. Dues to ASAA are possibly going to increase from \$4. Per student to \$5. Per student. An increase last occurred in 1996. The increased number of championships and medals given are the prime reason for the increase.**
- V. Region II will support the increase. Matt moved and Alan 2nd. Passed, 1 opposed.**

- VI. Soccer handbook. Dan Gallego reported the soccer handbook is still in the works. He asked to be reminded . Matanuska Christian is hosting an invitational tournament for co-ed soccer as a RegionalTournament.**

Region IV and V are looking into instituting fall soccer which would allow an ASAA sponsored State Tournament where coed teams would play vs. the boys.

- VII. Music Festival – Region II was asked by the music teachers from Delta, Valdez, Cordova, Tok, Tri-Valley, Nenana, Seldovia, and Su-Valley to continue to sponsor a music festival as a Regional event to allow participants to advance to the State Solo**

and Ensemble event. Matt moved and Dean 2nd to accept the Music Handbook as the official Region II guidelines. Passed.

Matt Clark was nominated for a two-year term on the ASAA State Board. Passed

Bernie Clark was nominated and elected to the Secretary-Treasurer position.

A plaque will be ordered and presented to Dean Overbey to thank him for his six years on the State Board. The students of Alaska and schools of Region II have benefited greatly from his service.

The 2002-03 Region II Seeding Committee was elected. Brian Williams of Heritage, Steve Jones of Seldovia , and Dean Overbey of Nenana will serve in this capacity.
