**The minutes from the fall meeting were approved. Dean O. moved 2<sup>nd</sup> by Doug B. –passed with the correction noted, adding Dean Overbey to the attendance.**

**The agenda was adopted with the additions and reordering. Moved by Dan P. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill J. Passed.**

**Dean Overbey's ASAA report.**

**ASAA Representative's Report**

**Dean Overbey reported: Region I has dropped their proposal to have additional overlap between small school's volleyball and the large school's season, the fifth game in varsity matches may use rally scoring , the 3<sup>rd</sup> game in j.v. matches may use it. Rally scoring is defined in the National Federation Rulebook. It will not be used at the State Tournament. Region II's request to play soccer in the fall has been approved. Reclassification as proposed was discussed. A straw poll showed that Region II believes that small schools will be adversely affected by this particular change, leaving schools under 100 students to compete for a single state basketball championship.**

## **Old Business**

**The Secretary-Treasurer will issue a letter to schools that do not pay their dues by the bylaw required deadline, stating , " You are no longer a member in good standing of Region II because of your non-payment of dues for the school year 200-. Therefore, you are not allowed to take part in any Region II sponsored events."**

**The handbooks for Girls Volleyball, Basketball, Wrestling, X-C Running, Track and Hockey were presented for approval. Dean O. moved, Dan G. 2<sup>nd</sup>ed to accept with noted revisions. Passed.**

**The request Region II made to the State ASAA Board for a full venue of berth's at appropriate State level tournaments for AAA schools was carried by Region II Rep. Overbey. Region II can expect a full slate of AAA tournament berth's at the appropriate State level tournaments when Region II has a minimum of three (3) schools in the current AAA classification. Discussion centered around the advent of Nenana becoming a AAA school and how long it would take for the State to respond appropriately. It will not happen the same year unless the State Board can have information well in advance, that causes it to act.**

**Heritage School was unable to secure the track at Palmer High School for the 2001 Region II meet. Su-Valley will host the meet at their school. The dates will be changed to May 17-18, 2001. Moved by Dean O. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dan G. Passed**

## **New Business**

**The By – Law revision workday will take place September 27<sup>th</sup> 2001 , the day prior to the Fall meeting. The Tournament Handbook revision took longer than anticipated. Julie W. will type old by-laws and e-mail them to Region Secy.**

**Region II will reimburse Su-Valley school for the purchase of Track Meet Management Software**

**for Region II. Dan G. moved 2<sup>nd</sup> by Doug B. passed**

**Region II Rep. Will request that the State make its selection of basketball officials for the AAA and AAAA tournament by January 31<sup>st</sup>. This will allow the smaller schools to select officials in a timely manner for District Tournaments.**

**A Regional Seeding Committee will be established. The Committee will be chosen at the Fall meeting of Region II. One representative will be chosen from each District in Region II. Seeding disputes will be forwarded to the committee by the Tournament Director with the dispute that the Board of Control can not resolve in a timely manner. Once the Seeding Committee has been contacted, its decisions will be final. The costs incurred from conference calls etc. will be considered a tournament expense. Bernie C. moved Dan P. 2<sup>nd</sup> . Passed.**

**District II requests their seeding criteria for the basketball tournament be changed to read, "If a home series does not occur , the next game played will count as a game for a home series. Ie. in tournaments other than Regional or District." Bernie C. moved Dan G. 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed.**

**District III request to change their tournament to a modified double elimination format with the consolation winner playing the loser of the championship game to determine the 2<sup>nd</sup> place seed at the State Tournament. The officials selection will follow the established procedure where coaches vote for the officials.**

**Bernie C. moved Steve K. 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed.**

**Unalaska requests to move to Region II District III. Upon State Board approval. Dan G. moved to accept, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Matt C. Failed.**

**Unalaska requests to move to Region II District III. Region II responded that we would request Unalaska to move to Region II.**

**Dan G. moved, Matt C. 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed**

**Region II will act at the Fall Meeting regarding District placement pending Unalaska's response and the State Board's action.**

**Tanana requests to move to Region II District I A.**

**Dan G. moved Dean O. 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed.**
