Minutes of Winter Meeting Approved as Corrected

ASAA Report by Matt Clark and Gary Matthews

- a. **Craig, a AAA school may play baseball and softball with smaller schools as a cooperative team**
- b. **DDF increase A through AAA qualifiers from 12 to 15**
- c. **Calendar revision- the ASAA calendar has some errors for the start time for some fall sports . Hockey and hockey cheerleading starts week 17,**

Oct. 20. Fall and co-ed soccer end Oct.11 . A – AA and AAA West and Mixed Six volleyball may be changed back to September 8th.

- d. The ASAA Board of Director Meeting is May 4,5,6.**
- e. Homer is now in the Greatland Hockey Conference.**
- f. Nenana's request to stay AA was denied. It will be a AAA school in 2003-04.**
- g. It was pointed out that foreign exchange students are not eligible if they stay with or have their housing arranged for by a member of the school's coaching staff.**
- h. There is a new committee to consider reclassification issues.**
- i. The basketball endowment game must be held at a specific time, [probably the first available weekend of the season], which will be determined by the Board and published.**

- j. There has been a request for ASAA to sanction girls hockey.**
- k. Grace Christian has proposed that girls' wrestling be a separate sport.**
 - 1. The question regarding whether a Dr. of Chiropractic is able to give preseason sport physicals. The legality will be researched, it is not approved at this time.**
- m. The National Federation has determined that all volleyball matches will use rally scoring by 2005. ASAA will determine whether it will be 03-04 or 04-05.**
- n. Officials certified by ASAA have not had a background check. It is up to the school or district to do this before hiring officials, if they so desire. It is assumed that schools that desire to do so, do background checks on their coaches.**
- o. ASAA has a proposal to consider that students incoming to a Boarding School are immediately eligible, if they have transferred at the beginning of a school year. They are not eligible if they transfer in or out at any other time. All ASAA rules on transfer apply.**
- p. ASAA has started to formulate a third 'strategic plan'.**

The treasurer's report was accepted as read. Moved by Matt C. 2nd by Dan Polta.

Soccer by-laws were read and accepted as amended. Dan Polta moved, Matt Clark 2nd. They will be forwarded to the Secretary and put on the Region II website.

Region II Coach of the Year for female sports is Scott Richardson of Matanuska Chrisian, girls basketball coach. The Region II Coach of the Year for male sports is John Gruber, boys basketball coach from Seldovia.

Region II Track and Field Championship will be at Su-Valley on May 16 and 17th.

Sportsmanship banners may be purchased form ASAA for \$75.

The C.I.A participation issue was resolved to ASAA's satisfaction and a letter of explanation was received by Gary Matthews and Dan Gallego.

District III's additions to the basketball handbook were discussed and will be added to the Region II Tournament Handbook on line. Bernie moved and John 2nd.

District II added a tiebreaker to the basketball handbook. Moved by Dan P. , 2nd unknown.

The proposed budget for Region II was adopted for 2003-04. Lynn Stowe moved, Dan P 2nd.
