ASAA Report

Region II Board Representative Matt Clark reported from the December Board meeting: Member schools are not using the Master Eligibility List appropriately and reporting transfers, especially Boarding Schools. Galena has been put back into Region II and assigned to District II, as they requested. The Greatland Hockey proposal passed, it will be implemented in '05. There is some concern surrounding officiating at the State Hockey Tournament. Reclassification is still on the table.

Gary Matthews with ASAA reported that the AAAA and AAAAA classification may be voted down or revised as the schools that are affected can not agree on conference arrangements. He also commented that the Boarding schools have had a variety of rules regarding the transfer of students 'in'. The rule regarding the students leaving the Boarding school has fluctuated as well. The students have been eligible as soon as they were properly registered at the Boarding School, following a summer transfer. The mid-year move home because of homesickness etc. did not fit the definition of 'hardship' and was not allowed. It seems that the State Board, in a recent hearing, has establish a change. After Gary ruled the transfer was illegal, the Board reversed the ruling and declared the mid-year move home, legal, as a hardship. The Small Schools Volleyball season has been moved back, [see the 03-04 ASAA calendar] as requested by Region I and II.

Old Business

Tanana will host the Region II District I-A basketball tournament for 2002-03. Participating schools are: Allakaket, Ft. Yukon, Tanana, Nulato, Cornerstone, and Ruby, according to Dan Gallego's research.

The rules for Region II Co-ed Soccer will be read and edited and submitted for adoption at the Spring 03 Meeting. Member schools must request a waiver from ASAA prior to playing non-member schools and may not play non-school teams.

The Sportsmanship packet, including the video, from ASAA, was copied and
